AUTOMATIC FIRE EXTINGUISHING SYSTEM

The electric system housed beneath the co-driver's seat next to the first aid kit contains three kilos of extinguishant. It gives the crew time to get out of a burning vehicle.




HANDHELD FIRE EXTINGUISHER

Located in the co-driver's footwell and used for putting out local fires.



ROLL CAGE

Strengthens the car body and can save the crew's life. Comprises 34 metres of chromoly steel tubes and weighs roughly 52 kilos.



TOOLS AND SPARE PARTS

The crew has an electric impact wrench and a manual wrench and other useful gear, like half a litre of engine oil and brake fluid, a spare belt, sticky tape and cable ties, glue, connectors and cable parts.



HYDRAULIC JACK

Lifts the car with each pumping movement of the lever, not with every second movement as is usually the case.



SPARE TYRE

The regulations require at least one and at most two spare tyres in the car.
